Real Stories

While the Sunshine Phonics books are decodable texts, they are also **real stories**! The stories in the early sets follow the adventures of Nat, Dan and Sam. All young children can relate to the fun storylines and enjoy the humorous endings. Later sets introduce other stories and non-fiction titles.

Words Children Can Read

The Sunshine Phonics Decodable Books allow students to practise their developing phonic knowledge by reading books that only include the sounds that they have learnt. Some tricky words (high-frequency words that are not easily decodable) are also learnt as these words are necessary for any story. The result is reading success for all children!







Teaching Support

Inside Front Cover

The inside front cover of each book provides the **Before Reading** focus for the children. Here they will review the sounds they have learnt and practise blending those sounds to make the words that they will meet in the story. Tricky Words are also reviewed.

Vocabulary Check: fit - What does it mean to "be fit" or "to get fit"? What does "Get set, go" mean? When is this used? She took the top off the bottle.

Story Discussion: Look at the cover. Who is this story about? What does the title tell us about this story? What kind of things could Dan do to get fit?

Teaching Points: Discuss the use of speech and thought bubbles in this story to show the talking (speech) or thoughts of a character. Ask children to find examples in the book. Introduce the purpose of an exclamation mark to show emphasis. Review s on the end of a verb, e.g. hop/hops.


