
Real Stories

While the Sunshine Phonics books are decodable texts, they are also **real stories**! The stories in the early sets follow the adventures of Nat, Dan and Sam. All young children can relate to the fun storylines and enjoy the humorous endings. Later sets introduce other stories and non-fiction titles.

Words Children Can Read

The Sunshine Phonics Decodable Books allow students to practise their developing phonic knowledge by reading books that only include the sounds that they have learnt. Some tricky words (high-frequency words that are not easily decodable) are also learnt as these words are necessary for any story. The result is reading success for all children!

Some "tricky words" are introduced. These are high-frequency words that are not easy to decode at this stage.


Teaching Support

At the end of each book, teachers will find a summary of teaching points for Before Reading and After Reading. This includes:


